Emphasizes the unique insights and perspectives made possible by interdisciplinary collaboration and provides students with a basic knowledge base for understanding Latin America today. <p>This course offers an in-depth examination of several key themes in Latin American & Caribbean Studies. Emphasis is placed on exploring the utility of interdisciplinary methods and on becoming familiar with the theoretical framework that underpins the field. This semester’s LAA 300 meets with ANTH 562 (“Mexamerica”) and will focus on the relationship between the US and Mexico and the situation of Mexican-origin communities in what is now the United States. A service-learning component involving support for organizations serving Spanish-speaking families in Kansas will be part of the coursework. Prior completion of LAA 100 recommended. This semester's LAA 450 will focus on Afro-Latin cultures and will meet with PORT 300/PORT 785. The interdisciplinary focus of this class allows students to connect what they have learned about major issues in the field of Latin American & Caribbean Studies with a thematic focus of the professor's choosing. By the end of the class and culminating their study of the field at KU, they will be able to discuss these issues from a variety of theoretical, methodological, and disciplinary perspectives as demonstrated in the portfolio of written work maintained throughout the semester. Prerequisite: Completion of 3 courses at the 300 level and above with Latin American content in the Humanities and 3 at the 300 level and above in the Social Sciences (that is, at least 18 credits toward the major); or permission of instructor.
